CHERRY-TODD ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS. June 23, 2020

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Directors of Cherry-Todd Electric Cooperative, Incorporated was held June 23, 2020, at 10:00 am CST via WebEx due to COVID-19.

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 10:04 am by President Tucker.

ROLL CALL: Present: Jerry Fullerton, Justin Brickner, Glen Yellow Eagle, Whitney Meek, Dan Valburg, and Sandy Tucker. Absent: Wayne Frederick, and Shawn Bordeaux. Also, in attendance were Manager Timothy Grablander, Support Manager Steve Tilton, Member Services Manager Beau Westover, and Attorney Jessica Hegge.

AGENDA: Yellow Eagle motioned, seconded by Valburg, to accept the agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

MINUTES: Meek motioned, seconded by Yellow Eagle, to accept the minutes of May 26, 2020 as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

FINANCIAL REPORT: Office Manager Theresa Benda entered the meeting at 10:13 am and presented the Financial Report.

Shawn Bordeaux joined the meeting at 10:15 am. Wayne Frederick joined the meeting at 10:20 am.

2019 AUDIT: Derrick Larson of Eide Bailly LLP joined the meeting at 10:26 am and presented the 2019 audit report and findings. Mr. Larson also presented the 990 Form to the Board.

POWER SYSTEMS ENGINEERING RATE STUDY: Manager Grablander shared the Power Systems Engineering Rate Study. The Board requested additional information regarding irrigation and would like a five year average and comparisons presented at next month's meeting.

MANAGER REPORT: Manager Grablander went over Cooperative business.

ATTORNEY'S REPORT: Brickner motioned, seconded by Yellow Eagle, to enter into executive session. Motion carried unanimously. The Board entered into executive session at 12:13 am. The Board exited executive session 12:49 pm.

STAFF REPORTS: Member Services Manager Westover reported on DRU's and Irrigations. President Tucker questioned Westover on safety issues. Westover was on a jobsite near a roadway without a reflective vest. Tilton pointed out to the Board that the Foreman is responsible for job site safety and should have addressed the concern on site. Reflective vests will now be placed in cooperative vehicles for management staff. Support Manager Tilton gave a report on equipment listed for sale on an auction site. President Tucker discussed that Tilton was not wearing a hard hat while operating the equipment from the lower controls. Tilton informed the Board that he had been made aware of the issue and he would be conscious of this in the future.

DONATION REQUESTS: Yellow Eagle motioned, seconded by Frederick to donate \$150.00 to the Valentine Lions Club. Motion carried unanimously.

Boys and Girls club donation request was tabled till next month. The Board requested the amount of last year's donation.

Yellow Eagle motioned, seconded by Bordeaux, to donate \$2,500.00 pending the ability of Antelope community to match those funds. Motion carried unanimously.

Frederick motioned, seconded by Yellow Eagle, to make a policy for Board donations. Motion carried unanimously. Attorneys Hegge and Larson will begin drafting a policy for the Board to review.

BEEF CHECKOFF PETITION: Brickner motioned, seconded by Bordeaux, that Cherry-Todd support the Beef Checkoff Petition. Motion carried unanimously.

ANNUAL MEETING: There was discussion regarding Annual Meeting preparations. The Board agreed by unanimous consent to offer a sack lunch to members that attend in lieu of a buffet style meal as a COVID-19 precaution.

President Tucker asked the board to consider a special in person board meeting to have an executive session. The board advised Tucker to set up a time and place.
