APPLICATION FOR ELECTRIC SERVICE
STOCK WATER WELL AND OTHER NON-RESIDENTIAL USAGE

Stock Water Wells and Other Non-Residential Usage, for the purpose of this application is defined as any electric water pumping installation located at a point remote from the established farmyard or town or commercial premises (if any), currently taking service from the Cooperative and which is to be used exclusively for watering livestock or other associated non-residential usage including farms which no longer have a residence in use.

The undersigned (hereinafter called the applicant) hereby applies for electric service and agrees to purchase electric energy from the Cherry-Todd Electric Cooperative, Incorporated, (hereinafter called the Cooperative) upon the following terms and conditions.

- 1. The Applicant will, when electric service becomes available, purchase from the Cooperative all electric energy used on the premises described below and will pay \$45.80 per month or \$549.60 annually to be determined from the following stock water wells or other non-residential usage.

Plus tax if applicable.

Contribution in aid of construction of \$4.00 per foot for the excess new construction over 575 feet and \$6.00 per foot in excess of 3000 feet. This will be charged as an advance payment before construction is started.

Provided, however, that where the applicant already has another service with the Cooperative then the following schedule will apply:

Contribution in aid of construction \$4.00 per foot for the excess new construction over 575 feet and \$6.00 per foot in excess of 3000 feet. This will be charged as an advance payment before construction is started.

The billing period shall be from December 1st of one year to November 30th of the following year and the minimum charge shall be payable in advance.

kWh to be paid for by converting annual consumption to monthly average:

First 900 kWh per month @ 16.561 cents
Over 900 kWh per month @ 9.882 cents

It is further understood that the above minimums and rates will apply for the life of this agreement, unless a general rate increase becomes necessary for the Cooperative patrons, and in such an event the rates and minimums under this contract will be increased in accordance with any new rate that the Rural Utilities Service of the United States of America may approve for this category of rate.

2. All poles, wire and related facilities required to extend the service to the well shall be installed by and remain the property of the Cooperative.
3. If after expiration of this contract, the service is not used during a period of two years, the Cooperative shall have the right to remove all facilities and discontinue service. In case the service is disconnected, the regular reconnect fee in effect at the time shall be charged.
4. The Applicant will cause his premises to be wired in accordance with wiring specifications approved by the Cooperative and the National Electrical Code as adopted by the State Electrical Commission.
5. The Applicant, by paying the meter deposit, assumes no personal liability or responsibility for debts or liabilities of the Cooperative and it is expressly understood that under the law, his private property is exempt from execution for any such debts and liabilities.

The acceptance of this application by the Cooperative shall constitute an agreement between the Applicant and the Cooperative, and the contract for electric service shall continue in force for five (5) years from the date service is made available by the Cooperative to the Applicant and thereafter until cancelled by at least thirty (30) days notice given in writing by either party to the other. Any future service must be for a period of one year or more, and with minimum payable in advance.
